VINIFICATION

Wine maker description A smooth rich wine made from the Cape's own grape

Pinotage blended with Cabernet sauvignon and Merlot. Abundant aromas of deep red cherry fruit, sweet caramel and fragrant cigar smoke. Opulent and long lingering.

Varieties 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Pinotage, 10% Merlot

fermented separately. After malolactic/secondary fermentation the wines were blended and placed in oak for 13 months. 25% in first fill 225L barrels, the rest in 3rd and

4th fill 300L barrels.
