## VINIFICATION

Wine maker description Full and complex. A multi-clone blend of five noble

varietals. Explosive and evolving aromas of dark ripe red plums, tea leaf and cigar box are followed by hints of pencil shavings, tobacco and trademark cassis character. A serious, tightly packed wine with a long lingering finish. A wine of great pedigree that will

reward cellaring. Decanting recommended.

Varieties Cabernet Sauvignon (57%), Merlot (19%),

Cabernet Franc (10%), Petit Verdot (10%),

Malbec (4%).

Origin Wine of Origin Stellenbosch

Vinification details These grapes received six days cold maceration

prior to fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Fermented at between 24-28°C for 1 and a half weeks. The wine was then moved into 225L barrels, 45% new French oak 225L barrels for 14

months maturation.
