### VINIFICATION

#### Wine maker description

Fresh full and complex. A multi-clone blend of five noble varietals. Explosive and evolving aromas of ripe red currants, tea leaf and cigar box are followed by hints of plum, tobacco and trademark cassis character. A serious, tightly packed wine with a long lingering finish. A wine of great pedigree that will reward cellaring. Decanting recommended. Try with roast lamb, venison, duck breast or beef dishes.

#### Varieties

Cabernet Sauvignon (60%), Merlot (20%), Cabernet Franc (13%), Petit Verdot (5%), Malbec (2%).

#### Origin

Wine of Origin Stellenbosch

#### Vinification details

These grapes received six days cold maceration prior to fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Fermented at between 24-28°C for 1 and a half weeks. The wine was then moved into 225L barrels of which 43% was new French oak 225L barrels for 14 months maturation.
